BUDGET PLAN

- We would like you to buy your economy tickets as soon as you are selected for the project. The reimbursement amount is for both ways and maximal amount for 1 participant.
- You need to upload all your tickets, boarding passes, invoices in google drive which the link will be shared with you: Simply take a photo of your tickets and upload your them in google Drive as PDF
- Tickets means tickets, invoices, boarding passes, receipts etc. This means all documents related to your traveling to Sweden and back to home.
- Please remember that without invoices-boarding passes, no-ticket can be reimbursed
- Travel (flights, other means of transport) expenses are compensated (up to 100%), based on the actual expenses incurred and the distance from your location of residence to the location of the project (Floda, Sweden).
- After prject ends and final report submitted, the money for your tickets will be sent either to ypur sending-organization or to your group leaders (who do you make responsible person so that will pay you)
- Accommodation, meals, and other project-related expenses: 100% funded by the EU and project

THE VENUE



Floda is a locality situated in Lerum Municipality, Västra Götaland County, Sweden. It is situated 54 meters above sea level at Lake Sävelångens entrance to River Säreån. Floda has a station on the Gothenburg commuter rail system, Alingsås line.

The station house was completed in 1903 but has gone through many changes since then.

Skallsjö Church in Floda was built in 1861–1863 to replace what today is the Skallsjö Church

ruins, situated two kilometers to the south-west of the church. The oldest parts of the original

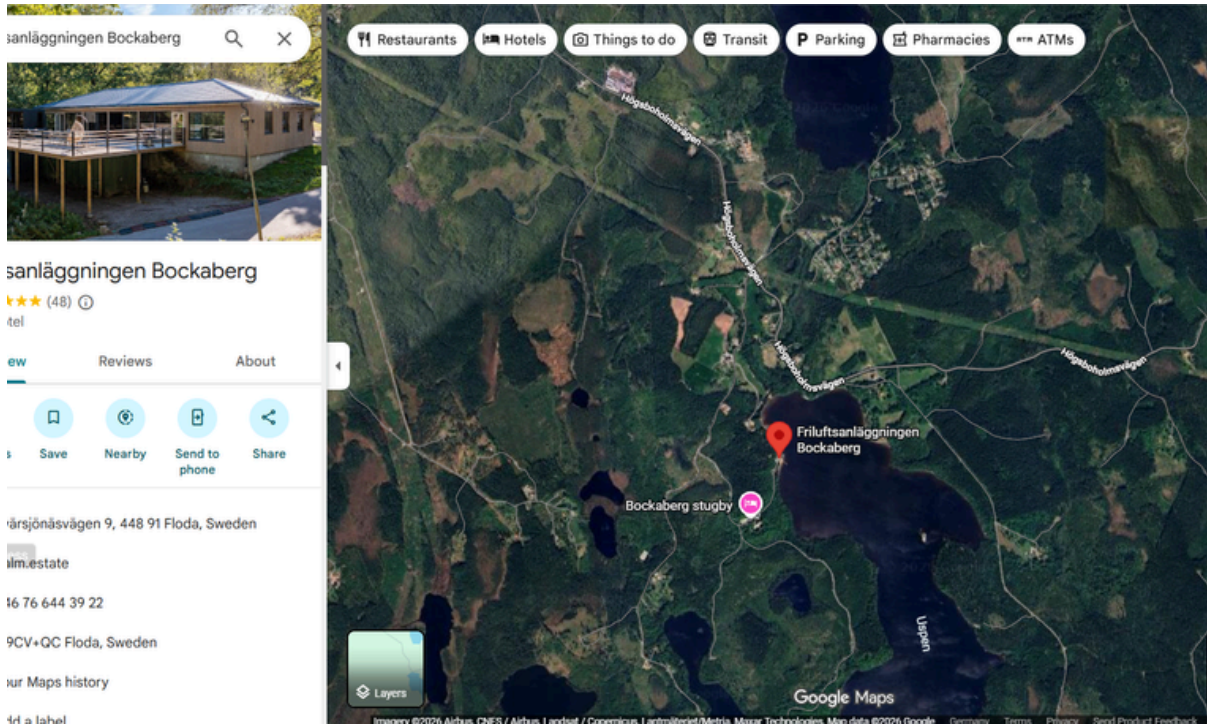
Skallsjö Church were built in the 13th century (1200-1299).

HOW TO ARRIVE IN PROJECT PLACE



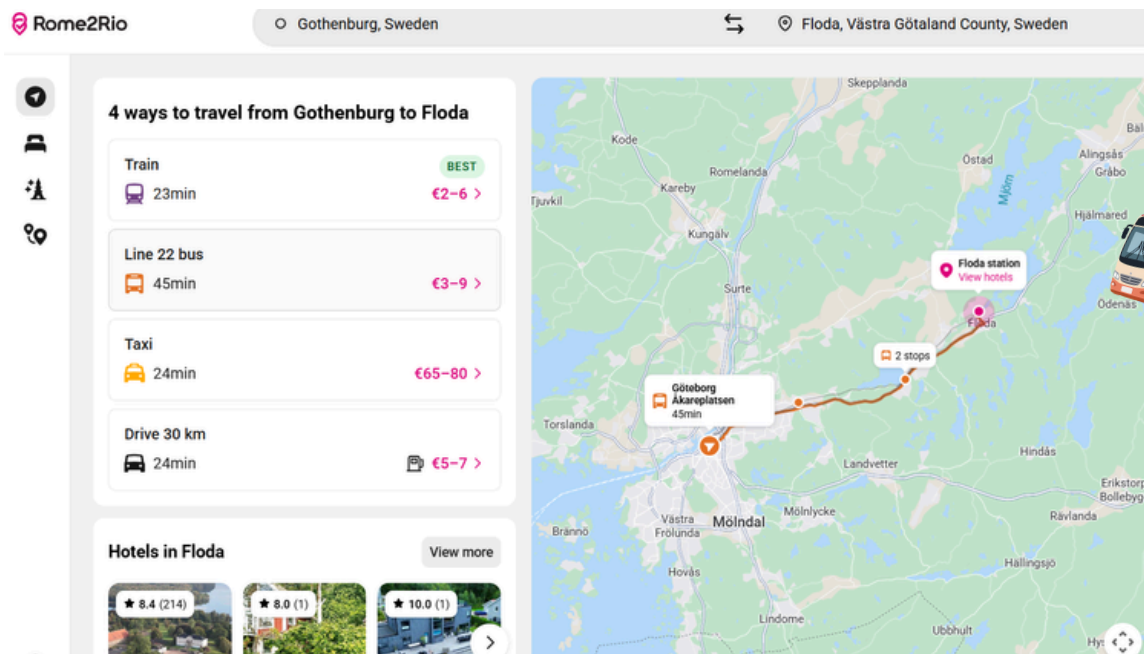
- **Floda** is a small town in nature, and it has no airport, but it is very close to **Gothenburg**. There is train and bus options for arriving in Floda.
- **Gothenburg Central Station** is 32 km away.
- The nearest airport is **Gothenburg Landvetter Airport**, 26 km from Lakehostel Floda.
- There is also ways to arrive in Floda from **Stockholm** airport.



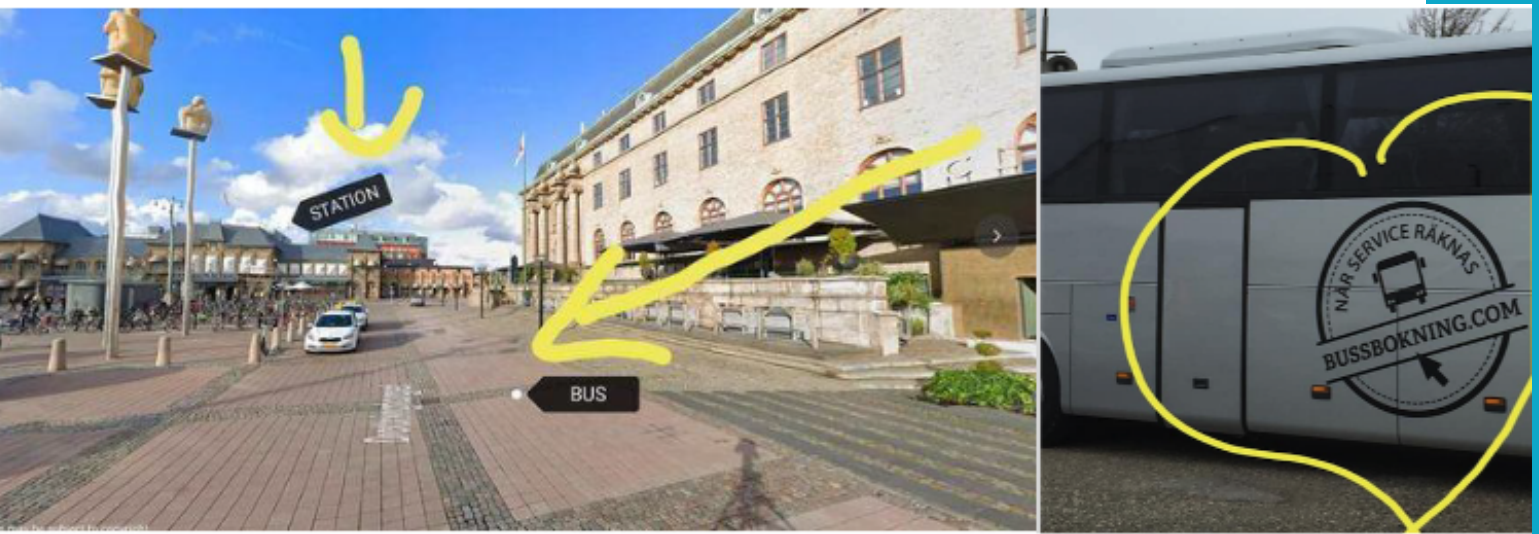

YOU ARRIVED IN GOTHENBURG CENTRAL STATION? WONDERFUL!



- After you arrive in Gothenburg Central Station, here is the bus station where you find the bus to the accommodation place Lakehostel Floda.
- The last bus is a bus at 19:00 pm named **BUSSBOKNING**.

- All participants need to arrive in Floda by means of public transports.

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS AND INFO

- 1) As soon as you accept to be part of our YE, you are considered that you accept the responsibilities and requirements. Therefore, please read requirements carefully.
- 2) Travel tickets: please start searching for your tickets and plan your whole trip. Don't forget that arrival date is 06 Sept 2026 (enough when you arrive to Floda, Sweden. You will be taken from the bus station after 14:00 pm. Departure date is 14 Sept 2026 (need to leave accommodation place before 12:00). Also please consider calculating everything - buses - flights-trains. Do not lose your boarding passes! You can stay extra days (up to 3 days before and after project) in Sweden. Also remember that all your expenses for accommodation and food during extra days will be on your own. Unfortunately, extra days will not be covered by project.
- 3) All travel documents, tickets, invoices, boarding passes need to be in original version and be uploaded as PDF in google Drive (links will be shared)
- 4) Without proof of traveling, tickets will not be reimbursed. More information you can get from your sending organisation. Besides this main info about arrival and departure will be shared on WhatsApp group (soon you receive the link).
- 5) Travel insurance - we highly recommend you that you have travel insurance just in any case. Bear in mind that those expenses will not be covered by project so it will be on your own expenses!
- 6) Preparation phrase – the sending-organizations are requested to organize an online orientation course. So, you can arrange an online meeting with your sending-organizations and other participants for knowing each other, getting more info about our YE, discussing your needs, suggestions, culture night etc.
- 7) Cultural night - as group, you are going to represent your country, therefore we would like you to take traditional food, snacks, drinks, dances, videos or any materials you will use and present. And it would be even better if you prepare your ideas with your teammates before you arrive in Floda.
- 8) Everyday there will be daily teams. Everyday different group might take responsibilities for preparing breakfast, helping Chief for lunch and dinner, cleaning the kitchen. Besides, Daily Report Teams will be responsible for writing Daily Report, too. More details about responsibilities and how to do it will be shared in the morning of second day of project.

IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS AND INFO

- 9) **Time-management:** Each group is responsible to be on time for activities. Group leaders will take responsibilities for making their national teams punctual and active. Please do not forget to cooperate with your group leaders.
- 10) We recommend you that you organize arrival and departure time with other members of your group. Do not forget that we can take you from the closest station, if you share info about your arrival time with us. We will have min. 2 vehicles for the usage of transportation. But just in case, please do not forget that you might wait up to 30 min for being taken from closest station. So, we ask for your patience.
- 11) The place of accommodation has its own rules (such protection of furniture and place, cleaning system). It means we must take care of the place and use it in proper way. You should notice that all the group will be absolutely responsible for possible expenses in any damage/break situation.
- 12) During the official part of the event, and in the territory of the whole campsite alcohol and drugs are strictly forbidden! Smoking is not recommended and in case only permitted outdoors in a designated space.
- Please remember that we have these “restrictions” for your safety and well-being. This is why we firmly believe that you would collaborate with our organisational team and we will have an unforgettable project full of learning and joy :)
- Your health, safety, and happiness matter! Therefore, the peaceful environment must be kept. So we do :)

WHAT TO BRING?



Please do not forget to bring your personal belongings (shampoo, towels, soap, medicine etc.) with yourself.

We will have a short-hiking section. So, please bring your proper clothes, shoes.

Since there will be international evenings, we will ask you to bring the materials and things that you think they present your country. Such as traditional, famous, delicious food, snacks, drinks, dances, videos, photos etc.

We want you to present your country in best way. So, you can prepare/find some videos-photos-maybe questions (kahoot)-or any fun game etc.

We believe in your imagination September is a perfect period in Sweden. Nevertheless, please check weather forecast before you arrive.

HEALT INSURANCE AND PREPARATION

HEALTH

Health insurance is not provided and will not be reimbursed by the organisers. All participants are strongly advised to purchase private travel insurance, as costs of private health care in Sweden are quite high if you don't have. Therefore, we strongly recommend every participant to acquire travel insurance at their own expense for the whole duration of the course. Also, please have a valid EU healthcare insurance card (if applicable).

PREPARATION

Each of the participating countries should.

- Bring all your travel documents as presented above.
- Prepare a presentation about your sending organization (initiatives they have previous projects, working regions, non-formal learning methods used, etc.).
- Get basic info about current situation in your countries about these areas: climate change, digitalisation, nature protection, recycling systems
- Prepare for your country's cultural evening. Please, try to be fun and creative for this! :) honest opinion: No one likes regular only powerpoint presentations. Any kind of activities are welcome (e.g., video presentations, dances, songs, games, language, tongue twister, quizzes etc.).
- Check the weather forecast before arrival and bring adequate clothes. Please also bring clothing and shoes that can be used for maybe outdoor activities.
- Bring good spirit, joy, and happiness
- If possible, take your laptops, digital cameras, smart phones and tablets – we will be doing multimedia works that requires digital equipments!
